Highlighted need for OUR LAST SCOOP!:

2. **Banner Carriers: Reminder:** Some parishes **have not** yet submitted the name(s) of your **Centennial** banner carrier. The **Centennial** banners (**Centennial logo, white background**) are scheduled to process through the main arena during the opening ceremony on Friday, June 11, 2010 at 6:30 PM and then again during the closing ceremony, on Sunday, June 13 at 2:00 PM. You may assign two different people to carry the banners; one for the opening ceremony and one for the closing ceremony to encourage involvement. The carriers may be male or female; must be **physically able** to walk through the arena and up some stairs; you may assign a single carrier or a couple to walk together (no more than two people per banner at a time). Please provide your carriers with the instructions sent in the previous mailing. The banners will lineup and parade according to their establishment date, (the oldest parish to the newest). It is imperative that the carriers are ready for instructions and lineup by the times stated above, (**Friday, June 11, 2010: register at 4:00 PM and pick-up identification tags, lineup at 5:00 PM for route directions for opening ceremony and again at 1:00 PM on Sunday for closing**). **Friday** carriers please bring the banners with **stands** into the civic center at the exhibit hall entrance (E42). An information and registration table will be at this entrance. **Sunday** carriers please check with the information booth located in the main lobby for directions to the instruction area no later than 12:45 PM and be assembled for instructions by 1:00 PM.

3. Volunteers: YES, we still need many. Please ask your fellow parishioners to call the diocese-they will connect you to the committee you are interested in to give you details. Toll free 1-877-405-7435 or 222-3035.

4. Your last major assignment: Announce at every mass this weekend about the centennial: It is free to all, lots of wonderful prayer, speakers, food, activities for teens, children, and adults.
